Japanese delegation visits Sri City



CHENNAI: A delegation of Japanese companies visited Sri City, India's first integrated Business City with a Special Economic Zone (SEZ) and a Domestic Tariff Zone (DTZ), 55 km from Chennai, to study the developmental activities happening there.
