

Korean delegation visits Sri City

TIRUPATI: A high-level Korean delegation comprising business leaders visited Sri City Special Economic Zone (SEZ) in Satyavedu constituency of Chittoor district on Saturday. The delegation was led by members of Korean Trade Centre (KOTRA), a state-run organisation of the Republic of South Korea.

Accompanied by Sri City Managing Director Ravindra Sannareddy, KOTRA head Byung-Suk Chang went around the 6,000-acre sprawling complex and exuded con-
