

Seven cos get land in AP industrial estates

Seven companies with plans to invest over Rs 3,000 crore were allotted land in two industrial estates in Andhra Pradesh at the valedictory of Suminfra 2009.

Together, these projects would generate over 17,000 jobs.

Two of these projects - SBQ Steels Ltd of the Chennai-based RKKR group for an integrated steel project, and Rockon Construction Systems for making earthquake- and tempest-proof building panels - are to come up at the Andhra Pradesh Industrial Infrastructure Corporation's industrial park at Nellore.

The others are to come up at Sri City, near Tada, about 55 km North of Chennai. The companies setting up plants

at Sri City are AS Cargo Movers, for a warehousing and logistics project; TIL Exports Pvt Ltd, for a manufacturing facility to produce pharma and nutraceutical formulations; Rockworth Systems Furniture, for making office systems and furniture; Lovepac Converting, Sweden, for making mobile phone components; and Saakar Printing and Design Engineer, which was allocated ready-built factory space to manufacture toner cartridges for laser printers.

Suminfra is a two-day conference on infrastructure organised by the Confederation of Indian Industry. Deliberations at the conference covered the theme of fast tracking infrastructure projects through public-private partnerships.
